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COMMISSION IMPLEMENTING DECISION

of 22.11.2022

approving the cooperation programme “(Interreg VI-A) IPA Bulgaria-Türkiye” for support from the European Regional Development Fund and the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance under the European territorial cooperation goal (Interreg) in Bulgaria and Türkiye

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THE EUROPEAN COMMISSION,

Having regard to the Treaty on the Functioning of the European Union,

Having regard to Regulation (EU) 2021/1059 of the European Parliament and of the Council of 24 June 2021 on specific provisions for the European territorial cooperation goal (Interreg) supported by the European Regional Development Fund and external financing instruments¹, and in particular Article 18(4) thereof,

Whereas:

- (1) On 20 May 2022 Bulgaria on behalf of Bulgaria and Türkiye which have agreed on the content of the cooperation programme pursuant to Article 16(5) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059 submitted, through the electronic data exchange system of the Commission, the cooperation programme “(Interreg VI-A) IPA Bulgaria-Türkiye” for support from the European Regional Development Fund (‘ERDF’) and the Instrument for Pre-accession Assistance (‘IPA III’) under the European territorial cooperation goal (‘Interreg’) in Bulgaria and Türkiye.
- (2) In accordance with Article 17 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, the programme supports a programme area from the list set out in Annex I to Commission Implementing Decision (EU) 2022/75².
- (3) The programme was prepared by Bulgaria and Türkiye in cooperation with the partners referred to in Article 8(1) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1060 of the European Parliament and of the Council³.

- (4) The programme contains all the elements referred to in Article 17(3) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059 and has been prepared in accordance with the model set out in the Annex to that Regulation.
- (5) The Commission has assessed the consistency of the programme with the multi-annual strategy document pursuant to Article 18(1) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059 and Regulation (EU) 2021/1529 of the European Parliament and of the Council⁴.
- (6) In accordance with Article 18 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, the Commission assessed the cooperation programme and made observations pursuant to paragraph 2 of that Article on 22 July 2022. Bulgaria submitted a revised cooperation programme on 7 September 2022.
- (7) The Commission concluded that the programme complies with Regulation (EU) 2021/1059.
- (8) Pursuant to Article 50 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, this Decision constitutes a financing decision within the meaning of Article 110(1) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046 of the European Parliament and of the Council⁵ with regard to the ERDF and the support by IPA III under shared management. It is necessary to specify the elements needed to make the budgetary commitments with respect to the programme in this Decision.
- (9) Pursuant to Article 112(1) and (2) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1060 and Article 13 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, it is necessary to fix, for each year, the amount of the total financial appropriations envisaged for the support from the ERDF and IPA III and, for each priority, the co-financing rate and the maximum of support from the Funds. It is also necessary to specify whether the co-financing rate for the priority applies to total contribution, including public and private contribution, or to public contribution.
- (10) As the total ERDF allocation to this programme is below EUR 30 000 000, the amount needed for technical assistance expressed in EUR and the resulting percentage should be fixed pursuant to Article 27(5) of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059.
- (11) The cross-border cooperation programme provided for by this Decision is in accordance with the opinion of the IPA III Committee set up by the relevant provisions of Regulation (EU) 2021/1529.
- (12) Pursuant to Article 59 of Regulation (EU) 2021/1059, in order to implement an Interreg programme in a third country, partner country or OCT, in accordance with Article 112(4) of Regulation (EU, Euratom) 2018/1046, a financing agreement should be concluded between the Commission, representing the Union, and each participating third country, partner country or OCT represented in accordance with its national legal framework.
- (13) The cooperation programme should therefore be approved,

HAS ADOPTED THIS DECISION:

Article 1

The cooperation programme “(Interreg VI-A) IPA Bulgaria-Türkiye” for support from the ERDF and IPA III under the European territorial cooperation goal (Interreg) in Bulgaria and Türkiye for the period from 1 January 2021 to 31 December 2027, submitted in its final version on 7 September 2022, is hereby approved.

Article 2

1. The maximum amount of support from the ERDF and IPA III for each year is set out in Annex I.
2. The maximum amount of support for the programme is set at EUR 29 252 963, to be financed from the following specific budget lines in accordance with the nomenclature of the General Budget of the European Union for 2022:
05 02 01 00.07: EUR 14 269 738 (ERDF - ETC – contribution to programmes supported by Instruments for Pre-accession Assistance 2021-2027);
15 02 03 00: EUR 14 983 225 (IPA III).
3. The co-financing rate for each priority is set out in Annex II. The co-financing rate for each priority shall apply to public contribution.
4. The amount needed for technical assistance is set at EUR 3 815 604 which results in 15% of the ERDF and IPA III contribution (without technical assistance).

Article 3

The Director-General of the Directorate-General for Regional and Urban Policy is hereby mandated to sign the financing agreement to be concluded with the Government of Türkiye on behalf of the Commission.

Article 4

This Decision is addressed to the Republic of Bulgaria.
